- **Surabaya Old Town:** Tourist attractions on Jalan Rajawali include the Cigar Building, PTPN XII Building, PTPN XI Building, International Building, Bank De Javasche, Kebonrojo Main Post Office, Historical Park, Red Bridge, Syrup Factory.
- **Suramadu Bridge:** Bridge is a cable bridge between Surabaya on the island of Java and southern Bangkalan Regency on the island of Madura in Indonesia. Opened in June 2009, the 5.4Km bridge is the longest in Indonesia and the second longest in the Southern Hemisphere.
- Lunch with the traditional Sinjay Duck Fried menu
- **Heroes Monument:** Built to commemorate the events of the Battle of November 11, 1945 in Surabaya, where Suroboyo fought against the Allied forces with the Dutch who wanted to recolonize Indonesia.
- **Submarine Museum:** This monument is actually a relic that still exists and is enjoyed until now, namely the submarine KRI Pasopati 410, one of the fleets of the Republic of Indonesia Navy made by the Soviet Union in 1952.
- **Tunjungan Street:** Since the beginning of the 20th century has become one of the commercial centers of the city of Surabaya. This road is a connecting road that is the main shopping area in Surabaya.
- **Passing through Grahadi:** State Building in Surabaya, East Java that was built in 1795 during the reign of Residan Dirk Van Hogendorps (1794-1798) which is now the center of Surabaya's government.
- **Surabaya Square:** Originally built in 1907, it was known as Simpangsche Societeit or Simpangsche Club as a nightlife venue for European elites, especially Dutch citizens. Locals affectionately call it "Roemah Football Room" because of the pool games held there
- Dinner with menu traditional Surabaya Rawon : Indonesian beef soup. Originating from the Javanese cuisine of East Java, rawon utilizes the black keluak nut as the main seasoning, which gives a dark color and nutty flavor to the soup thus rawon is often
- Return to the airport/hotel
